# Our Goal

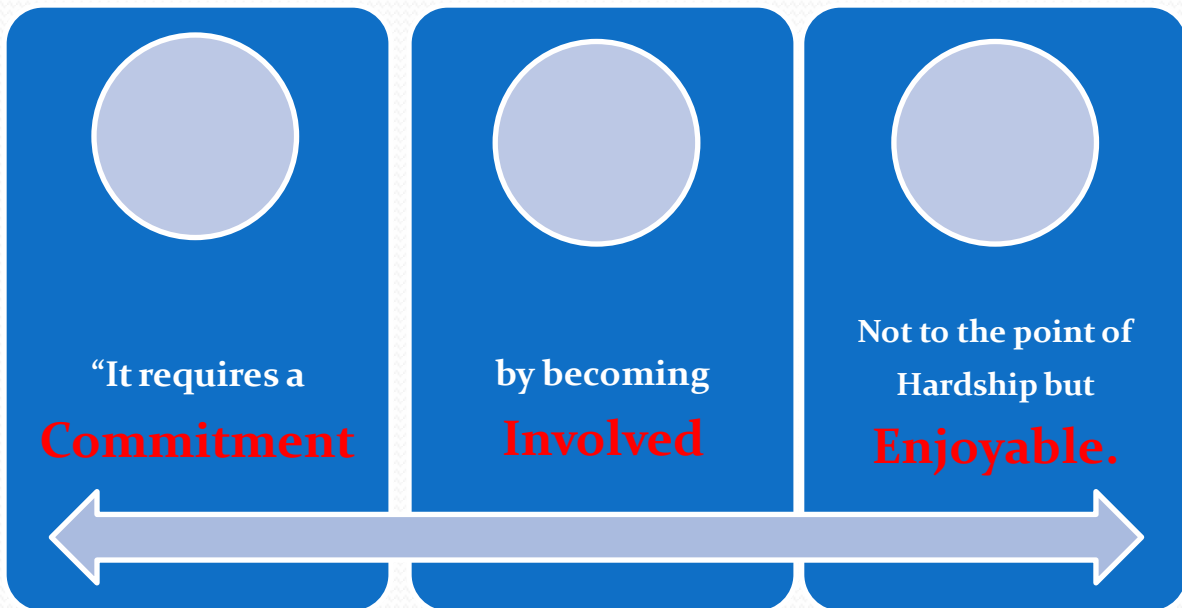
**“Be Connected”**

## Luke 6:38

### SEED FAITH.

Jesus opened up a whole new way of giving. He gave himself totally to and for the needs of the people. We can no longer pay or sacrifice our way into God's Mercy. Jesus Christ has paid our debt before God, and his Cross is a completed work in our eternal interest.

Our GIVING, then is no longer a debt that we OWE, but a seed we SOW.

The life and power source is from Him. Ours is simply to act on the power potential in that SEED LIFE He has placed in us by His Power and Grace.

Notice that when Jesus said "Give", He also said "and it will be given to you"
